Due to the generosity of a couple of corporations and multiple sponsorships from our hometown companies and residents, the new sound system conduit will be in place by the end of the day, March 27th and Audio-Visual Solutions will start hanging the speakers and running wires. When I started this job, the sound system seemed to be an insurmountable project. How was the Fairgrounds supposed to come up with the almost \$18,000 it was going to take to complete the project? But Weston County proved once again that WCFG is where "Weston County Comes Together." We will have a new sound system by the High School Rodeo. Both Black Hills Energy, the Wyoming Business Council, and Powder River Energy generously donated large sums of money that almost cover the cost of

the sound system equipment, but that was only half the project. Then donors like 21 Electric, 1st Call Locates, Andy's Service Company, David and Stephanie Kline, the Wyoming Honor Camp and its crews, and an anonymous donor covered the supplies, equipment and labor to putting in the conduit basically free to the FGs.

At this point we are only about \$3000 short of completely funding this project through the generosity of Weston County and the companies who do business here. Thank you, Weston County, for your support, not only of this project, but all the changes and new ideas I have brought since I started nine months ago.
